## What is Arthurs Shed?



Arthur's Shed is a purpose-built studio set in the beautiful grounds of the Arthur Rank Hospice. Sessions are open to the public and free of charge although a suggested donation of £5 is welcomed. Sessions can be booked onto by calling 01223 675871. To keep everybody safe sessions must be booked onto in advance.

**Astronomy:** Learn all about the sun, moon and stars and build your very own sun dial! (We recommend attending all 6 sessions)

**Paper Crafts:** Learn to make paper hedgehogs and other seasonal gifts.

**Card Making:** Learn to create beautiful cards, follow a design or see where your imagination goes.

**Mixed Media:** A fun way to explore your creativity, try pastels, paints and collage to create something unique.

### Coronavirus:

To ensure everyone's safety we:

- Ask that you wear a mask throughout the session
- Have limited each session to 4 people to socially distance
- Ask that you cancel your session if you or someone you live with has covid 19 symptoms, is waiting for a test result or have been asked to self-isolate
- Ask our volunteers to test regularly
