The Arthur Rank Hospice Therapy Team includes both Physiotherapists and Occupational Therapists who specialise in palliative care. We aim to improve your quality of life and focus on rehabilitation and symptom management. We work with you to attain goals and maximise independence with self-management strategies. We work across our Living Well Service, the Inpatient Unit, the outpatient Pain Management Group and in the community and you can either be seen at home or at the Hospice.

Our services

Our Support helps you to manage your symptoms and functional activities alongside any medicines you have been prescribed. This may include:

- Breathlessness, fatigue, anxiety, and pain
- Mobility and maintaining your independence
- Muscle strength/exercise
- Reducing the risk of falls

- Relaxation and sleep hygiene
- Personal care and leisure activities

If you are a patient on the Inpatient Unit, are being supported by our Living Well Service or are having care by one of our specialist nurses, please ask for a referral.
