


Lymphoedema Service

Self-Measurement Chart for Legs

The measurements of your leg(s) are remaining steady, so the provision of your compression hosiery, that is available on prescription, is being transferred to your GP via Patient Choice. Compression hosiery should be renewed every six months and it is important that you measure your leg(s) prior to your prescription request.
