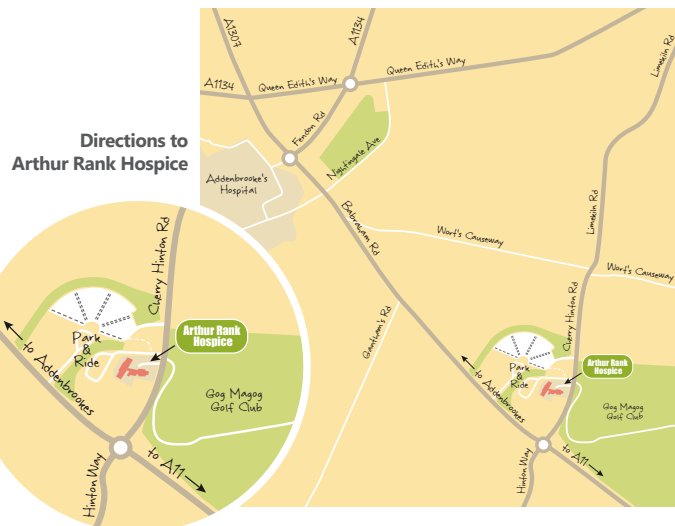
## Link Days for Care and Nursing Home Staff - NEW
