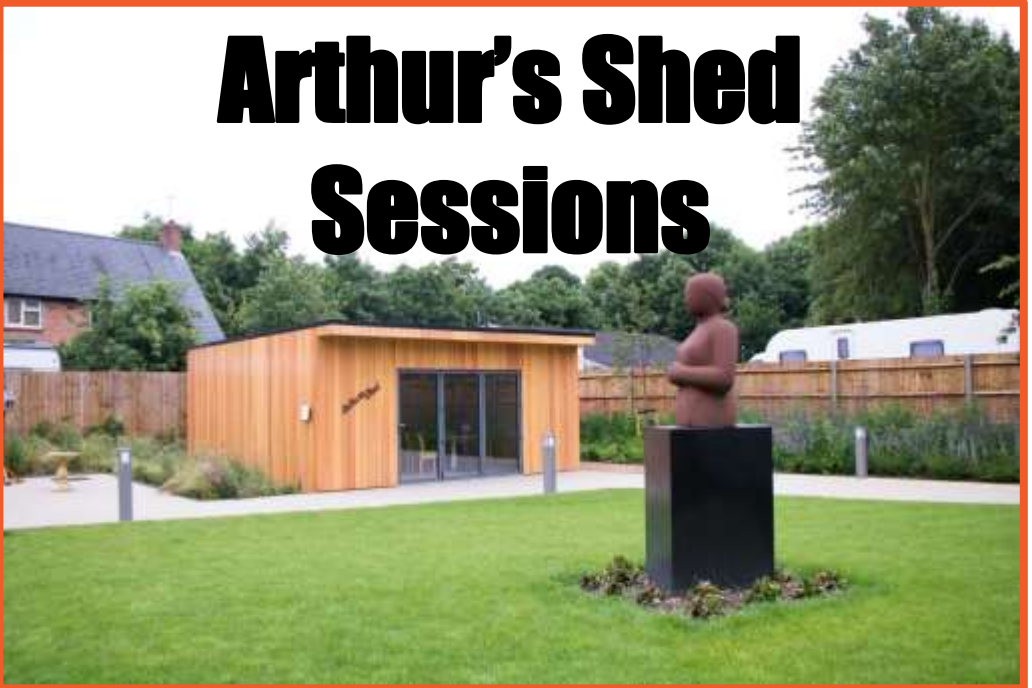


# Arthur's Shed Sessions
